Did You KNOW?

- One in 7 African American men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer and a greater percentage die of the disease. It is the second leading cause of cancer death in African American men.
- Prostate cancer is more likely to develop in older men and in non-Hispanic Black men.
- About 6 cases in 10 are diagnosed in men who are 65 or older, and it is rare in men under 40.
- The average age of men at diagnosis is about 66.
